

Title: Albert Trostel and Sons Company

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Abstract: Albert Trostel, a native of Wurtemberg, Germany, began a tannery business with August Gallun in 1858, a partnership that lasted 28 years. After the partnership ended, Trostel operated the business on his own, acquiring the Phoenix tannery on Commerce Street in 1885. His sons eventually joined the business, which grew into one of the country's largest tannery operations.
