**Abstract:** From a very early period in the city's history, Milwaukee made several attempts to provide clean water to city residents, but it was not until April 1871 that the Milwaukee Water Works was established, and the utility began operations on Sept. 14, 1874. It is the longest continuously operating water utility in Wisconsin.

**Scope and Content:** The collection includes articles of association, annual reports, monthly bulletins, reports, abstracts, pamphlets, publications, maps, histories and litigation.
