Abstract: Pancratiuous Tiefenthaler had a long career in Milwaukee education, first as a teacher of German and later as the principal of the 9th District School.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of correspondence, notes, speeches and other ephemera. Tiefenthaler's dismissal as principal of the 9th District School in 1906 and the aftermath of that occurrence is the subject of much material within the collection.
