**Abstract:** The Milwaukee Bar Association co-sponsored Freedom Week, a week-long event commemorating the anniversaries of significant U.S. events concerned with the freedom of the country between December 7th (10<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the attack on Pearl Harbor) and December 15 (160<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the adoption of the first ten amendments to the Constitution). Representatives from numerous Milwaukee community organizations constituted the membership of the steering committee.
