Abstract: Since the Andres family arrived in Milwaukee in 1855, they were connected to the stone and marble business. Fred Andres established the Andres Stone & Marble Company in 1880, and served as president of the company until his death in 1916. His son, Edgar, rose to lead the company for more than 30 years. Fred's daughter, Margaret, married into the Hughes family.

Scope and Content: The collection contains a 1916 memorial resolution from the National Association of Marble Dealers re the death of Fred Andres; photos and miscellaneous material related to Frank and Margaret (nee Andres) Hughes cruise to South America in 1959; Margaret and Frank Hughes' passports; Margaret Hughes' National Republican Victory Certificate, 1978; insurance policies for Eleanor Jean Andres; Eleanor Andres' membership certificates in the Alpha Xi Delta and Beta Beta Beta fraternities, 1947-1948; Edgar F. Andres' booklets regarding the Dale Carnegie course, 1948;
