Abstract: The Thirty-Second Division was formed in 1917 from Wisconsin and Michigan units and fought in several major campaigns during World War I. It was known as the “Red Arrow” Division and dubbed “Les Terribles” by the French. The Veteran’s Association was formed immediately after the end of the war to celebrate the division’s achievements, honor those who fell in battle, and maintain the bonds forged during the war. The association has continued that mission throughout subsequent U.S. conflicts.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of reunion programs, commemorative booklets, proclamations and resolutions, menu, maps and Christmas card.
