Abstract: Charles Healy Powell was a University of Wisconsin graduate who volunteered for a six-month enlistment in the American Ambulance Field Service during World War I (Dec. 1916 to July 1917).

Scope and Content: The collection consists of Powell's diary, military documents, roster, maps and photo albums. His diary contains a day-to-day view of the hazardous duty ambulance drivers faced.
