Abstract: From September 15-18, 1941, Milwaukee was the host city of the American Legion's national convention. By all accounts, the gathering was a huge success. A parade of some 50,000 participants along Kilbourn Avenue drew an estimated crowd of more than 500,000 onlookers.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of convention packets, programs, newspaper clippings, proceedings, directories, pamphlets and other ephemera pertaining primarily to the 1941 convention in Milwaukee. There are also a menu from the 1938 convention in Los Angeles and a program for the 1939 convention in Chicago.
