Abstract: Gregory Logan was a long-time resident of Milwaukee, Lake Geneva (Wisconsin), and southern Florida. He and his family members owned several Milwaukee-area businesses such as bars, clubs, and cocktail lounges during the early to mid-20th century.

Scope and Content: The records of the Logan Family include personal and business correspondence, receipts, advertisements, newspaper clippings, portraits and public photographs, assorted interior and exterior scenery photographs (bars, lounges, restaurants, coastal, and marine environments), and assorted postcards.
