Abstract: Arthur Shavzin was born on July 4, 1921, in Milwaukee, the youngest of eight children born to Russian immigrants. During World War II, he served in the Army Air Corps with the 9th Phototechnical Squadron, processing and printing aerial photos. He worked as a professional photographer after the war before earning a degree in social work from the University of Wisconsin. He worked as a psychiatric social service supervisor with Milwaukee County for 32 years. He and his wife, Charlotte, were married for 59 years, and they had four children. He passed away in May 2016.
