**Scope and Content:** Nathaniel Kruglak was born in Ukraine. His mother and father immigrated to the United States in 1928. He had two siblings Haymand and Bernard. He attended Marquette University and the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee. Mr. Kruglak loved to learn about how the democratic process worked and how to make it more efficient. In 1956 he worked with the city council, civic organizations, and labor unions to facilitate the process to register to vote. He helped establish 22 polling locations in the city of Milwaukee to facilitate the voting registration process. He worked extremely hard to inform his fellow residents on the importance of voting. The collection includes awards of merit for Mr. Kruglak's work in the county-wide "Get out the Vote Campaign" of 1956, newspapers clippings and a magazine article concerning Mr. Kruglak.
