**Abstract:** Otto J. Templin was a druggist who operated a pharmacy at 2200 West National Avenue on Milwaukee’s South-Side from 1915 to 1940. He married Emma Jones in 1908 and had one daughter, Mildred. The Templin’s were active in the Evangelical Lutheran Church of the Redeemer. Templin was a member of the county, state, and national pharmaceutical associations and was also President of Milwaukee Veteran’s Druggist Association. Also, Templin was a 32<sup>nd</sup> Degree Mason, a member of the Excelsior Lodge, and Vice-President of the Triangle Class of the Wisconsin Consistory. Templin died in Milwaukee and is buried at Forest Home Cemetery.

**Scope and Content:** The collection consists of correspondence, photos, postcards, journals and other ephemera pertaining primarily to the Templin and Jones families.
