Abstract: Columbia Hospital was founded in 1909, taking over the Knowlton Hospital and Training School on Sycamore Street (now Michigan Avenue). The Knowlton School was renamed the Columbia Hospital School of Nursing. In 1919, Columbia moved to its current site on Maryland Avenue. In 1995, Columbia established a joint operating agreement with St. Mary's Hospital of Milwaukee. Columbia Hospital closed its building complex in 2010 with the opening of a new Columbia St. Mary's Hospital, and the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee purchased the old Columbia buildings.
