Abstract: Cornelius McGillicuddy, better known as Connie Mack, was one of the more influential figures in baseball history. He is best known for his nearly 50 years as manager of the Philadelphia Athletics from 1901 to 1950, but he also has ties to Milwaukee. He was player/manager of the Milwaukee baseball club from 1897 to 1900, and he maintained ties to the city after taking the job in Philadelphia. Several of the Athletics' stars of the 1920s were from Milwaukee, and one Milwaukee native, Otto Schomberg, served as one of Mack's talent scout.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of three letters from Mack to Otto Schomberg as well as a copy of an article re Mack and Schomberg in the 1968 *Historical Messenger*.
