**Abstract:** Andrew J. Langworthy was involved with iron works, foundry, machine shop, threshing machine and wagon manufacturing. He served as Sheriff of Milwaukee County (1858-59) and was also Captain of Company K of the Second Regiment Milwaukee Volunteers during the Civil War. He was also a member of the Masons, Milwaukee Lodge No. 2.

**Scope and Content:** A large portion of this collection consists mainly of Civil War correspondence, documents, and orders. There is some personal information included on both his wife and daughter, along with other miscellaneous correspondence and materials associated with Langworthy himself.
