Abstract: In 1944, the Mayor's Committee on Inter-Racial Relations was formed. The name was changed in 1948 to the Mayor's Commission on Human Rights, an indication that the group's focus was broadened beyond only black-white relations to include "intergroup and interfaith relationships." The Milwaukee Common Council adopted a resolution in July 1954 that changed the name again to the Milwaukee Commission on Human Rights, and finally, in 1960, the name was changed to the Milwaukee Commission on Community Relations.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of meeting minutes, annual and general reports, newsletters, correspondence and other ephemera.
