Abstract: The Milwaukee City Guards were one of several militia units formed during Milwaukee's early years. Established in 1848, it was Milwaukee's first Irish company. Under an 1854 reorganization, the unit became the Milwaukee Union Sarsfield Guards.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of an invitation to a military ball at Johnson & Murphy's Brick Block, East Water St. on December 12, 1848. Also an April 1908 newspaper clipping on the history of this artifact.

Access and Use: Patrons use only photocopies of original documents.
