

**Title:** Joint Committee on Consolidation in Milwaukee County

**Abstract:** In January 1934, the Milwaukee Common Council and the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors each appointed a committee of fifteen citizens to study the potential consolidation of city and county government functions. To avoid duplication of efforts and improve efficiency, the two committees met and re-organized as a consolidated committee. One committee recommendation was the merger of Milwaukee city parks and suburban parks under the jurisdiction of the Milwaukee County Park Commission, a move which voters approved overwhelmingly in 1936.
