Abstract: The Wisconsin Citizen/Labor Energy Coalition (C/LEC) was established in 1978. As part of the national Citizen/Labor Energy Coalition, the group worked to achieve energy reform and equitable state energy policies. In 1982, the organization changed its name to Wisconsin Action Coalition and broadened its scope beyond energy concerns. By 1985, the organization's name was changed again to Wisconsin Citizen Action.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of various energy tax studies, reports, and state legislation material that pertains primarily to the C/LEC's efforts to encourage the imposition of a state tax on oil company profits made within Wisconsin.
