Abstract: Dr. Gustav Schmitt was a tuberculosis fighter in the 1880’s and a physician in Milwaukee for more than 50 years. He also served as president of the Wisconsin State Tuberculosis Commission and president of the Steuben Monument Association.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of correspondence, speeches, articles, newspaper clippings, research material and an obituary/eulogy for Dr. Schmitt’s wife Mary.
