Abstract: Norman Sussman was a member of Wisconsin's Democratic Party and served in Wisconsin's State Assembly (1957-1960) and State Senate (1961 to 1969). He was born on May 26, 1905, in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. He attended the Milwaukee School of Engineering. Sussman was also a member of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees. Sussman passed away on April 20, 1969.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of correspondence from constituents, interest groups and government departments; copies of State Senate bills; drafts of State Senate bills introduced by Sussman.
