Abstract: Karl Ratzsch opened the Old Heidelberg restaurant at 116 E. Mason Street (now 320 E. Mason) with his wife Helen in 1929. By 1937 it was renamed Karl Ratzsch's at the same location. Karl also owned the Fox and Hound restaurant and both enjoyed national recognition. Karl Ratzsch was involved with the Wisconsin Restaurant Association for more than 25 years and served as president for several years. In addition, Karl Ratzsch, Jr., wrote a column for the Wisconsin Restaurant Association's newsletter. Mr. Ratzsch was a founding member of the Ozaukee Country Club and a member of the Milwaukee Athletic Club.

Scope and Content: The collection contains correspondence, newspaper clippings, articles, menus and other ephemera. There is information on the Ratzsch family genealogy, including material on Otto Herrmann, Karl's father-in-law and owner of Herrmann's Café. There is also material relating to the National Press Club and Milwaukee Press Club as well as the 1957 inauguration of President Eisenhower, which Ratzsch attended.
