Abstract: Five women organized the MacFadyen Club in 1918. Initially, it was called the “MacFadyen Circle,” but the name was changed to MacFadyen Club in 1922. Its purpose was to promote a greater knowledge and love of music and its affiliated arts. It was named in honor of Milwaukee pianist Alexander Mac Fadyen (1879-1936). In 1988, the club merged with the Wauwatosa Music Club to become the Wauwatosa MacFadyen Music Club.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of meeting minutes, yearbooks, newspaper clippings, historical sketches, programs and other ephemera.
