Abstract: The United Performing Arts Fund (UPAF) was formed in 1967 to promote the financial stability of organizations that would perform in the county's new Performing Arts Center (PAC), which opened in 1969. The founding organization included the Milwaukee Symphony Orchestra, Chicago Symphony Association of Milwaukee, Milwaukee Repertory Theater, Bel Canto Chorus, Florentine Opera Company, Skylight Theatre and Music for Youth. During its 50th anniversary year, UPAF raised more than \$12 million in support of performing arts in southeastern Wisconsin.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of annual reports, campaign reports, newsletters, advertising material and other ephemera.
