**Abstract:** Peter Engelmann was born on January 24, 1823, in Argenthal, Germany. He spent one year at the University of Heidelberg before moving to Berlin in 1843 where he concluded his studies. He received his teaching license in 1846 and began his teaching career at Kreuznach Gymnasium. Here he became involved in political events, becoming the editor of a democratic newspaper. Because of his political affiliations he was pressured to flee to America.

Engelmann arrived in New York in 1849. He made his way to a township near Milwaukee where he began teaching students, mostly from German parents. After the term ended he moved to Milwaukee. Here he worked with others to develop the Milwaukee School Association and the German-English Academy. The school was founded in 1851 and students were taught partially in English and partially in German. Engelmann served as director of this school until his death in 1874.

**Scope and Content:** The collection contains material relating to Engelmann and the National German-American Teachers Seminary. The Seminary material includes minute books of the administrative board, schoolbooks, catalogs, reports and yearbooks. The material related to Engelmann includes correspondence, genealogical information (including marriage record and naturalization record), newspaper clippings, and pamphlets. Also included is an autobiography with both the original handwritten script and the translations. There are also memoirs in the collection by an unknown author, and other miscellaneous material.

Access and Use: No restrictions

Language: German, English

**Notes:** Mrs. Robert Ian Stanley donated the majority of the collection in 1969. Jerry Carroon processed the collection in the 1980s. Amanda Wynne reprocessed the collection in 2009.
