Abstract: Jacques Vieau was a fur trader for the Northwest Fur Company when he established a trading post in 1795 at what became the City of Milwaukee.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of correspondence (1853-1905), warranty/tax deeds (1866-1907); various bills (1900-1917), genealogical/biographical records, pamphlets (1890-1926); a catalog from the Luening Conservatory of Music (1890); music programs re Wilfred Vieau/Vieau Harmony Orchestra (ca. 1901-1902); an article “Jacques Vieau and his House” (1926), and other ephemera related to Jacques, Wilfred and other members of the Vieau family. Also included in oversize items are three diplomas from Common School for Wilfred, 1890, 1892 and 1893.
