Abstract: Herbert W. Tullgren (1889-1944) was one of Milwaukee's more prolific architects, though he had no formal architectural education. After graduating from the Staunton Military Academy in Virginia in 1908, Herbert returned to Milwaukee to train in his father's (Martin Tullgren) architectural firm. Martin passed away in 1922, and Herbert continued working on his own. He embraced the Art Deco and Art Moderne architecture that flourished in the 1920s. He designed (and his firm built) several apartment buildings, including the Viking and Hathaway apartment buildings on East Kane Place. He also helped design Milwaukee's Parklawn Housing Project.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of one catalog and one advertising piece for an exhibition on Tullgren's work held at the Charles Allis Art Museum.
