**Abstract:** Victor R. Greene was a professor of history at the University of Wisconsin—Milwaukee. He earned a BA from Harvard University (1955), an MA from the University of Rochester (1960), and a PhD from the University of Pennsylvania (1963). He became a faculty member at UWM in 1971 and became a noted scholar in the fields of American immigration, labor, and popular culture. He was active in many professional and community history organizations, including the Milwaukee County Historical Society. Dr. Greene passed away on September 5, 2014, at the age of 80.
