He was a member of several committees and boards, including Finance-Printing (chairman, 1964-1972), Health-Traffic, Board of Estimates, Budget Examining Committee, Board of Purchases, City Records Committee, Urban Committee, Interim Convention Center Governing Board, Museum Committee, and Library Board of Trustees.
