Abstract: The Milwaukee Brewers are the city’s major league baseball franchise. The team originally was the expansion Seattle Pilots in the American League. After only one season, the financially strapped Pilots were purchased by a Milwaukee investor group, led by Alan “Bud” Selig. The team was relocated to Milwaukee for the 1970 season and was renamed the Brewers. The Brewers remained a part of the American League until the team agreed to switch to the National League for the 1998 season.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of programs, yearbooks, media guides, newspaper clippings, magazines and other ephemera.
