Abstract: The Milwaukee Christian Center was formed in 1921 to provide a recreational/group activity center for the poor and immigrant residents on Milwaukee's near south side. Initially, the center was located within the South Baptist Church at S. 6th and Washington streets, but the construction of the freeway system in the 1960s prompted the center to move to a new location at 2137 W. Greenfield Ave. Over the years, the Center has evolved to provide a wide range of social services at several south side locations.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of a 1961 fund-raising booklet regarding the Center's relocation to a new site; an invitation to an open house in honor of Rev. Ken Smith's retirement; and the Center's 2002-2003 annual report.
