**Abstract:** The Milwaukee County Safety Building (821 W. State St.) was constructed in 1929 and originally housed the central police station, City and County courts, City and County jails, and the County Sheriff. In the 1990s, the county moved prisoners to a newer facility, leaving the Safety Building to house courtrooms and legal offices.

**Scope and Content:** The collection consists of correspondence, memos, reports and plans concerning the remodeling of the 5<sup>th</sup> floor of the Safety Building. It includes specific requests from judges concerning the layout of the new courtroom and chambers.
