

**Title:** Paprocki, Paul and Irene Collection

**Abstract:** Paul Paprocki and his wife Irene (nee Lesniewski) were lifelong Milwaukee residents. Paul was born October 11, 1912, and Irene was born July 28, 1913. They married on January 26, 1935, and had three sons: Robert (1935), Gilbert (1939), and Gerald (1941). Paul worked with the Milwaukee Church Supply Company (which became T.H. Stemper Co. in 1946) for many years as a bookkeeper and designer of church altars, while Irene was a clerk at Boston Store on Wisconsin Ave for many years. Irene died September 30, 1971, and Paul passed away on February 29, 1972.

**Scope and Content:** The collection consists of ten very detailed daily household expense ledgers, 1930-1971. One ledger is loose on the shelf.
