**Abstract:** Anna Meyer McGee was wife of Charles A. A. McGee, Milwaukee County District Attorney circa 1910s, noted Republican politician, and great-grandson of Solomon Juneau. She was born in Bremen, Germany in 1883 and married in 1905, the year after the death of Charles A. A. McGee's first wife who was also Anna's sister. The McGee family moved to California in 1913, where Charles would continue his law practice and eventually run for governor in 1918.

**Scope and Content:** Collection includes a booklet titled "Bits of Family Lore," written by McGee as a Christmas gift for her family containing a history of the McGee, Meiner, and Meyer families. Names mentioned in the family history include Solomon Juneau, Jacques Vieaux, John Hays Hammond, Mark Hanna, and Robert LaFollette, Sr. Also included is a letter of explanation from donor Louise Schoenleber, a member of the extended family.
