Abstract: Frederick C. Miller was born in February 1906. He attended the University of Notre Dame, where he starred as a lineman on the football team for famed coach Knute Rockne. Frederick was named president of Miller Brewery in 1947, sparking a period of tremendous growth for the business. He was a generous philanthropist and avid sportsman. He played a key role in bringing the Boston Braves to Milwaukee. His life was tragically cut short when he was killed in a plane crash on December 17, 1954.
