Abstract: Mathilde Georgine Schley was born in May 1864 in Horicon, Wisconsin. She and her sister moved to Milwaukee in 1894 to start a dressmaking business but turned her attention to a career as an artist and writer. She wrote a number of articles on the German migration to the United States, which were published in the German-American press. She and her sister also built an apartment building, Schley Apartments, where they lived. She passed away in March 1941.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of Schley's typescript journal VIII (index in front) and two booklets, in German, entitled *Fritz, Pat, Jules und Hank* (1940) and *Deutschamerika* (1935), Westside Printing Co., Milwaukee. Also included is a catalog of the 14th Annual Exhibition of the Society of Independent Artists (1930).
