Abstract: Edward Scofield was born in Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, in March 1842. He fought in the Civil War with the 11th Pennsylvania Reserve Regiment and was taken prisoner at the Battle of the Wilderness. In 1868, he moved to Oconto, Wisconsin, where he embarked upon a successful career in the lumber business. He was elected to the Wisconsin State Senate in 1886 as a Republican, and in 1896 he was elected Governor of Wisconsin. He died in February 1925.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of Governor Scofield's Thanksgiving Day proclamation, November 29, 1900.
