Abstract: George Peckham Miller was born in Milwaukee in October 1858. He attended local elementary schools before attending Pennsylvania College at Gettysburg. After he graduated in 1877, he traveled to Europe and studied law at the universities of Goettingen and Breslau. He returned to Milwaukee and was admitted to the bar in 1881. He quickly became one of Milwaukee's most prominent attorneys.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of an invitation to the wedding of Elizabeth T. Miller to Brigadier General William Mitchell; a receipt from Thatcher Laboratories of Milwaukee, 1924; a stock certificate from Cozad Canal Company, 1909; and a sketch of the George Miller house by Steve Slaske, 1980.
