

Title: Zimmerman, Fred R. Collection

Abstract: Fred Zimmerman was born in Milwaukee in 1880. After he finished grade school, he worked at various jobs (a delivery man for a dairy, a salesman for a leather goods company, and bookkeeper for a lumber company) before he turned to politics. From 1909-1910, he served a term with the state assembly and also won election as secretary of state in 1922. He won the 1926 gubernatorial election as an independent, but he was defeated in the 1928 campaign. He was again elected secretary of state in 1938 and served in that capacity until his death in 1954.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of the articles of association for the American Tool & Production Co. signed by Secretary of State Zimmerman, 1923, and Governor Zimmerman's proclamation to convene a special session of the Wisconsin legislature, 1928.
