Abstract: George New was born in Bethlehem, Pennsylvania in 1894. His father was a friend of the artist James McNeil Whistler, who influenced and encouraged George as a youth. He served as a pilot during World War I, and after the war, he studied in Paris, Rome, London and Yale University. He earned a Ph.D. in Art and Archeology from the University of Paris in 1924. He gained international fame as an artist and also taught at Marquette University and Mount Mary College. His etchings included Milwaukee's City Hall, Public Library and St. John's Cathedral. He passed away in 1963.
