

Title: Wisconsin Avenue Viaduct Collection

Abstract: The Wisconsin Avenue Viaduct was constructed across the Menomonee River Valley in 1911, Milwaukee's first large-scale concrete arch bridge. By 1992, it had deteriorated to the point that it needed to be replaced.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of a request for proposals and two souvenir booklets concerning the 1911 bridge and informational bulletins, newspaper clippings and reports about replacing the bridge in the 1990s.
