Abstract: John T. McCutcheon was born May 6, 1870, in Indiana. He received a Bachelor's degree from Purdue University in 1889 and then moved to Chicago. He found work as a cartoonist with the *Chicago Morning News* (which underwent several name changes) before joining the *Chicago Tribune* in 1903. He was most noted for his sympathetic and nostalgic portrayals of rural life in the Midwest, but he also gained fame as a political cartoonist and war correspondent/artist. He worked for the *Tribune* for 40 years. He passed away in June 1949.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of a scrapbook of McCutcheon's cartoons, July 1903 – August 1904.
