**Abstract:** Fr. Leo John Dehon founded the Congregation of the Priests of the Sacred Heart in France in 1878. The focus of the order's work was to promote devotion to the Sacred Heart, educate seminarians, and work in foreign missions. The Congregation spread across Europe and throughout North and South America and Africa. The monastery for the Congregation's first American seminarians opened in Hales Corners, Wisconsin, in 1929.
