**Abstract:** Milwaukee's Civic Center encompasses an area downtown stretching from Wisconsin Ave. on the south, Highland Blvd. on the North, 10<sup>th</sup> St. on the west, and N. Water St. on the east. It includes several government buildings – the County Court House, City Hall, and the State Office Building – as well as cultural institutions such as the Milwaukee Public Library, Auditorium, Arena, Performing Arts Center, Milwaukee County Historical Society, and Public Museum. Proposals for a Civic Center were discussed as early as 1909, but not until 1920 did Milwaukee citizens approve a referendum designating the present site as the Civic Center.

**Scope and Content:** The collection consists of reports, publications, brochures, flyers, newsletters, newspaper clippings that discuss the planning and development of the Civic Center/Plaza as well as various buildings in the designated area. Also included is a map of the Kilbourn Avenue Improvement Plan, 1934.
