Abstract: A group of socially prominent residents of Milwaukee's east side formed the Milwaukee Country Club in 1895. Its first clubhouse was a converted residence on Lake Drive in what is now Shorewood. Though not the club's primary purpose, golf quickly became an important part of the club's activities. The first course was a pasture on Milwaukee's north side bordered by Locust Street and Hartford Avenue between Downer and Oakland avenues. Urban development prompted the club to move in 1910 to a new site farther north along the Milwaukee River in present day River Hills.
