Abstract: George H. Salentine was a long-time bookkeeper and salesman in the City of Milwaukee.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of two scrapbooks. The first, entitled “Milwaukee As I Saw It,” contains newspaper clippings on miscellaneous Milwaukee scenes, landmarks, businesses and social events, as well as obituaries of Katherine Salentine and Mary Salentine. The second, entitled “Memoirs of Days Gone Bye,” has clippings on non-Milwaukee topics and a few articles on Bay View, Wauwatosa, and St. Francis Seminary. Also included is a letter from Archie Martin of Nome, Alaska, to Salentine, 1938.
