Abstract: Mackie Gilbert Westbrook was born in Madison, Wisconsin in November 1931. He received a masters' degree in urban history at UW-Milwaukee under the supervision of Dr. Frederick Olson and worked in the Local History Room at the Milwaukee Public Library. He served with the military occupation forces in Austria during the Korean Conflict and then returned to private before embarking on a 35-year career as a public administrator. He became administrative assistant in the City Clerk's office in 1965. Two years later, Westbrook was appointed Information Secretary to the Common Council. He passed away in March 2020.

Scope and Content: The bulk of the collection is made up of resolutions, speeches, and correspondence of Milwaukee aldermen. Research done by Mr. Westbrook's office and statistics and information provided by that office to Milwaukee aldermen constitute a major part of the collection.

Access and Use: No restrictions

Notes: Westbrook donated the material to MCHS from 1973 to 1977. Boxes 28-32 contain files of Sandra J. Wright (later Mrs. Mackie Westbrook) who served as an administrative assistant in the City Clerk's Office. She was Clerk to the Committee on Bridges-Grounds-Harbors, and the Committee on Finance-Printing, known as Finance-Personnel after 1972.
