Abstract: Francis Paul Prucha, S.J., was one of the preeminent scholars of the federal government's Native American policies. His seminal work *The Great Father* was a finalist for a Pulitzer Prize in History in 1985. He was a long-time history professor at Marquette University and a former president of the Milwaukee County Historical Society. He passed away in July 2015.
