Abstract: Arthur Rabe (1886-1981) was born and raised on the family's 15-acre farm in Whitefish Bay. His father, Charles, was one of the earliest settlers in Whitefish Bay, arriving in 1849. Arthur helped incorporate the Village of Whitefish Bay and served as its first street commissioner. became an auditor for the AFL-CIO in 1940 and worked in that capacity until he retired in 1958.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of a list of violin engagements and fees collected by Rabe (1906-1925); a *Guide to Bookkeeping* prepared by Rabe for the Milwaukee Regional Office of the AFL-CIO; a receipt for a violin and case purchased by Rabe (1928), Rabe's registration card (1918); a clipping and obituary re Rabe; an appraisal for a Whitcomb violin (1980), and an article on violin-maker Wallace B. Whitcomb (1941).
