Abstract: Walter Schutz was born in Milwaukee in January 1900 and attended the University of Wisconsin in Madison. After a career in sales and advertising, he and his wife Sophie Sievers moved to Washington Island, Wisconsin in 1970, and started a business designing and building weaver's looms. In 1979, they established the Sievers School of Fiber Arts in 1979. Schutz also authored books on wooden toys, bird feeding and his boyhood in Milwaukee. Sophie died in June 1983 and Walter passed away in August 1990.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of a copy of Schutz's obituary, an article about the Sievers School, and a letter and pamphlet from Ann Young who took over the school.
